There are various ways that voting is made accessible for people with disabilities. For example, you can:

- Receive personal help at the polls or on Election Day.
- Have touch screens or other accessible devices at the polls.
- Arrange to vote by mail from your own home.
- Participate in supervised voting at your residential, assisted living, or nursing home.
