

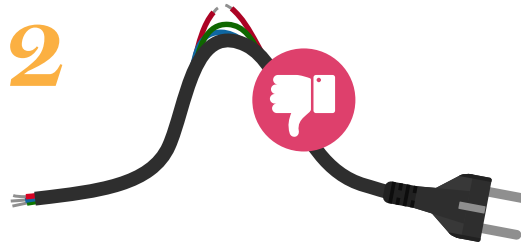
10 HOME ELECTRICAL SAFETY TIPS



1 Coil up and secure any excess cord length.

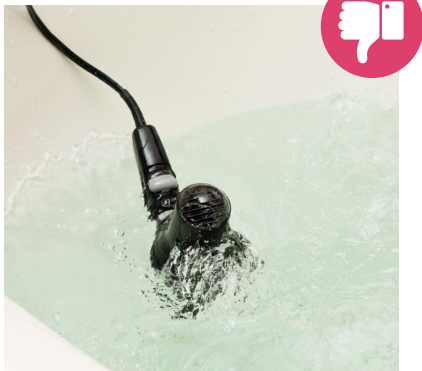
If cords or plugs show any sign of wear or damage, stop using immediately and replace.

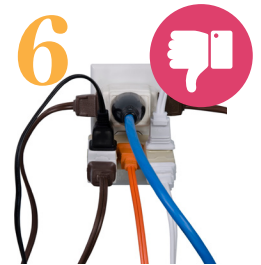
Use outlet covers to protect pets and children from potential harm.

4 Keep all electrical devices away from water.



5 Never run a cord under a rug, under a carpet, across a doorway, or anywhere it can be stepped on.

Don't overload outlets.



7 If you need to plug multiple items into an outlet, use a certified surge protector.

9 Never unplug a device when your hands are wet.

When unplugging an electrical device, make sure you pull the plug and not the cord.



10 Whenever you have any wiring that needs to be done, make sure to call a certified electrician.
